## TRANSFORMATION TOOLKIT



Use native/climate appropriate plants Minimzes need for irrigation

- Control stormwater runoff
- Reduce heating/cooling costs - Extend life span of roof membrane
- Improve air and water quality

Triple-glazed, south-facing windows maximize passive solar heat gain and

- Superinsulation, in the form of thick insulation: R-40 walls, and R-60 roof
- Highly airtight envelope, with 0.8 air changes per hour at 50 Pa

## VILLAGE ON MAIN



### Dartmouth's Main Street is transforming into an age-friendly community

he words age-friendly community come with one hig

"Quite often, people think we're creating a community for seniors. It's not that at all," said Graziella Grbac, he executive director of the Village on Main Community Improvement District in Dartmouth, an area covering the Main Street area that runs from Highway 111 to Caledonia Road between Lakecrest and Tacoma drives.

According to the World Health Organization (WHO), an age-friendly city adapts its structures and services to be accessible to and inclusive of older people with varying needs and capacities.

In other words, the communities are designed to commodate people of all ages and are meant to allow eople to stay in a community over the course of their

Age-friendly communities share certain characteristics uch as denser, more compact living spaces, they're walkable and they have social supports for people of all ages.

"Generally, people don't want to be dislocated from their nmunities to get the housing and the health care they need, and we have a lot of that happening in Nova Scotia. It's very detrimental to our health system and to our local economies when the population base gets dislocated," said David Harrison, an urban planner and development con-sultant who helped steer the Village on Main through the planning process of becoming an age-friendly community. The Village on Main is aiming to become a certified age

friendly community, a process which is overseen by WIIO.
This is the fourth age-friendly community plan Harrison has worked on in Nova Scotia, but none have been for a neighbourhood — they've all been for larger communities like the Town of New Glasgow and the District of Chester Harrison said he thinks the Village on Main will be

the first age-friendly community in IIRM once it receives approval from WHO.

For the Village on Main, it was a community-driver process and included representatives from all three levels of government, business people, health professionals and The planning approach involves looking at what

Harrison calls an "eight to 80 planning approach."

"We look at what 80-years-olds might need and if we can plan for that, we'll pick up everyone else in the

Looking at the construction of a hypothetical mixed-used building with 80 residential and five comcial units, the analysis found there was a larger return on investmen and shorter payhack period when building sustainably.

Specifically, the sustainable return

on investment was calculated to be \$7.8 million with a break-even period of 18 years, while it was \$4.7 million design. Some of the features of the sus-

tainably-built model include having a green roof, triple-glazed, south-facing windows, a heat-recovery ventilator and using native/climate-appropriate plants for landscaping.




