




Transit in Dartmouth

However, there is potential for improvement for inter-community service in peripheral areas such as Dartmouth.



VOM Involvement

In the form of letters, testimonials, public engagement, and external studies, The Village on Main has voiced concerns about the following transit issues:

- People in many parts of Dartmouth (including District 4) have limited access to Main St. and other hubs
- Transit in Dartmouth is centred on getting people to and from the Halifax Peninsula during peak hours
- Redundant bus routes within Dartmouth

And support initiatives including:

- A bus route on Main St.
- Leading With Transit
- Revamping the transit system with the purpose of providing mobility to as many urban/suburban areas as possible

Moving Forward Together Plan Pillars

The Moving Forward Together Plan best fits the needs of the peninsula, leaving significant gaps in Dartmouth. We believe that the plan misses opportunities to fully serve many Dartmouth communities.

- Increase the proportion of resources allocated towards high ridership routes
- Build a simpler, transfer based system
- Invest in service quality and reliability
- Give transit increased priority in the transportation network







Travel Time by Bus from DT Halifax & Cole Harbour to Burnside Industrial Park: 8am





Travel Time by Bus From DT Halifax & Cole Harbour to NSCC Akerley: 9 am








Travel Time From East Dartmouth Community Centre to Montague Road: 7 pm








Travel Time from Russet Lake to Burnside Industrial Park: 8am









Travel Time by Bus From Mic Mac Mall to Penhorn Terminal & Halifax Peninsula: 9:30 pm










Travel Time from Portland St. to Burnside Industrial Park: 8am






Travel Time by Bus from Keystone Village & Citadel Hill to NSCC Akerley: 9 am






Travel Time by Bus From North End Halifax & Tam O'Shanter Ridge to Dartmouth Crossing: 11am




